Read on to find out about what your child will be working towards during Summer Term

Personal, Social & Emotional Development.

- This term we will be supporting our Nursery children to accept simple resolutions suggested by an adult to move play on.
- We will be encouraging children to use self calming techniques independently.

Communication & Language

- The children will be learning how to talk about the settings, characters and structure of stories.
- We will be developing their understanding of answering questions using new and relevant vocabulary.

Physical Development

- The children will be working on developing their pencil grip, tracing and copying lines. For those who are ready we will be focussing on name writing.
- Now most children can put their coats on independently we will be focussing on using fastenings.
- We will continue to work on all children using the toilet independently.



Literacy

- The children will be exploring lots of different farm stories, describing main story settings, events and principal characters.
- During our phonics sessions the children will be practising oral blending skills and those who are ready will be introduced to new sounds of the alphabet.

Mathematics

- This half term the children will be learning to use positional language and how to finish and create repeating patterns.
- We will continue to develop and secure the children's number knowledge to 5 and beyond.

Understanding the World

- We will be learning about life on a farm.
- After half term the children will be learning about people who help us.

Expressive Arts & Design

- The children will be refining their drawing skills as we focus on adding more details to our drawings.
- We will continue to play our musical instruments and practise following a beat.
- The children will have plentiful opportunities to engage in role play with our ever changing role play area.
