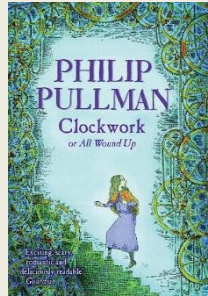


Year 6 - Walbottle Village Primary School - Autumn Term Homework
